BUSINESS ENTITIES THAT WE WILL VISIT

Tianjin

Tianjin city is famous for its strong industry. Being an old industrial city and manufacturing base, the city boasts a strong ICT, biomedicine, aviation etc. industry. Currently, with great efforts to develop artificial intelligence, biomedicine, new energy and new materials, Tianjin strives to build itself into a R&D base of advanced manufacturing.

Tianjin is constantly improving its business environment to facilitate the settlement of foreign companies.



Tianjin Technology Innovation Center

TTIC is a state-of-the-art research and development facility. The center was established in 2009 with the aim of promoting technological innovation and entrepreneurship in the region. It focuses on a wide range of research areas including new materials, renewable energy, advanced manufacturing, biotechnology, and information technology. They have a strong emphasis on interdisciplinary research, both in China and overseas.



Beijing



Beijing is the capital of China and one of the most





populous cities in the world. It has a thriving economy that is split into different areas of Beijing. It has financial centres, shopping centres and it is a major centre for electronics and computer-related industries. The southeast of Beijing is becoming a new centre in pharmaceuticals, information technology, and materials engineering. It is also home to 54 Fortune 500 companies. The city is an important centre for international trade and investment, with a growing number of foreign businesses establishing operations in the city.

GTOG Investment

Established in 2004, GTOG Investment helps startups through VC/PE financing and consulting services. They engage in assets worth more than 10 billion RMB. Their sectors of focus are IOT, Intelligent Devices, Fossil Energy, Modern Agriculture, Retails, Aerospace, Bio-Medical and Education.

Almakers

A professional incubator focusing on AI and machine learning project incubation. They offer global connections to industry alliances, R&D institutions and industrial parks in order to build a global ecosystem.

Shanghai

Shanghai is a global financial centre and one of the most important cities for international trade in China. Located on the east coast, it is China's largest city by population and one of the most densely populated cities in the world. Shanghai's economy is driven by a diverse range of industries, including finance, technology, manufacturing, and services. Shanghai's port is the busiest in the world, making the city a crucial centre for global trade and investment.

neoBay

An incubator that helps international startups which focus on science and technology. Their most prevalent fields include AI / big data / deep learning, advanced manufacturing / robotics, carbon-neutral technologies, intelligent healthcare, bio-agriculture. They offer business license applications, accounting & tax services, HR management, space leasing, policies and governmental support, branding & advertising services and more.







Cangzhou

Located in northeast China, in Hebei province, Cangzhou's economy is dominated by the petroleum and petrochemical industries. The city is home to a



number of other heavy industries such as steel production, shipbuilding, and machinery manufacturing. Cangzhou is an important sea gate, and it plays a big role in the regional economy. It is one of the important cities in the Beijing-Tianjin-Hebei one-hour circle. It takes 51 minutes to Beijing and 22 minutes to Tianjin by train. Cangzhou has become one of the cities with the most developed integrated transportation network in North China.

China-CEEC SME Cooperation Zone

A key partner with Central and Eastern European CEEC SME Cooperation Countries. Zone encompasses the petrochemical industry, building materials logistics, modern agriculture and also highend manufacturing. They are currently focusing on the introduction of light aircraft R & D and manufacturing, energy-saving and environmental protection equipment manufacturing, new energy vehicles and parts manufacturing, high-end medical equipment manufacturing, agricultural machinery and equipment manufacturing, modern facility agriculture and other projects.
